

Balance and Transaction Reporting

The International Account Information service enables you to control the balances on your various accounts in order to optimise your liquidity management as well as to reconcile incoming and outgoing transactions.

International Account Information is available via your electronic banking system on your accounts with all of the Nordea units as well as with most banks.

Types of reports

The following types of reports are available to meet your different needs,

- Customer Statement Message (MT940)
- Balance Report (MT941)
- Interim Transaction Report (MT942).

Customer Statement Message contains of balance and transaction information and shows all entries posted since the previous statement as



well as the opening and closing balances.

The Balance Report is an intra-day report showing the balance on the account at a given time of the day. It is an important tool for efficient liquidity management.

Interim Transaction Report is an intra-day report showing debit and credit entries of the account at a given time of the day. With Interim Transaction Report you get closer control of your incoming and outgoing payments.
